\Box Criteria for special situations: justifiable use of force by victims, preventing suicide, use of force on pregnant women, use of force on juveniles, SWAT callouts, etc.
□ Police vehicle in use of force situations
☐ Police canines as use of force during emergencies
☐ Multiple officer take downs
☐ Performing physical arrests and detentions in emergency situations, including restraint devices
☐ Use of force against fleeing felons
☐ Other issues as they apply to conflict resolution during emergency incidents
